# <u>Sophia from FMT – "Music in May (MIM)"</u>

- Poster is now out on all forms of social media! Please do share and support.
- Every day in May, something musical will happen. Anything music related: gigs, workshops, music based crafts etc etc......
- Multi venue and multi genre.
- So far 95 events scheduled across 14 venues.
- Wave 1 events deadline is March 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Wave 2 events deadline is April 1<sup>st</sup>. Beyond this you'll be too late to be added to any printed collateral such as a "pocket guide" (but digital promotion will still be possible).
- We are investigating whether we can create an app for the event (if not this year, then next).
- Venues: even if you're not a usual "music" venue, you can still take part! If you're already a venue, then please do organise events in line with the event calendar. Make it big because you'll get a bigger audience as the event is amplified through the media.
- Creatives: talk to venues about organising gigs, workshops, jams, busks etc.
- Everyone else: join in, support the events and tell your friends:
  - #folkestonemusictown (this should always be used when posting anything to do with music).
  - $\circ \;\;$  #musicinmay (use for anything do with MIM).
  - $\circ$   $\;$  #everydayinmay (for anything do with MIM).
- We will be creating a Music in May Tune (with a release + a video) based around recent work by Helen Sharp and Randolph Matthew. Showcase aimed to be at Silver Screen at the start of May.
